## Five-year-old Kindergarten (K5)

K5 supplies are purchased by the teacher. Reimbursement should be made to her on the night of parent orientation or the first day of school. *Parents are responsible for purchasing a plastic nap mat, a solid color book bag (no wheels), an old oversized t-shirt (to paint in), a change of clothes in a labeled gallon size Ziploc bag.*

## Grade 1

First grade supplies are purchased by the teacher. Reimbursement should be made to her on the night of parent orientation.

*Please make sure you purchase an NIV Bible and a solid book bag (no wheels) for your child to bring the first day of school.*

## Grades 7-12 General Supplies

tracing paper and colored pencils-(9<sup>th</sup> grade Geography students only)

Subject area teachers will give students a list of additional supplies for special projects when needed.

### 7-8<sup>th</sup> grade Math

3 ring binder (or a section of a binder) – no spirals  
notebook paper (college-ruled)  
graph paper (about ¼” spaces) – only required occasionally, but may be used anytime  
(this may help if messy writing is leading to errors)  
binder pouch recommended for supplies (pencils, protractor, ruler, compass, etc)  
6 inch ruler\* (inches and centimeters) – available in class (\$0.50)  
protractor\* (small clear) – available in class (\$0.50)  
compass (for drawing circles)  
2 working/sharpened pencils at every class period  
(even if you have mechanical pencils, you need two, in case one breaks – ONLY USE  
PENCILS FOR MATH WORK, no pens)  
2 red pens (for checking)  
colored pencils (just a few colors, 8-pack is fine)  
calculator is allowed during one chapter, but not required,  
(very simple, inexpensive)

## Algebra Supply List

- 3 ring binder (no spirals)
  - homework section
  - notes section
  - graph paper section
- section dividers for binder (at least 3 sections)
- notebook paper (college-ruled)
- graph paper (about ¼" spaces)
- binder pouch recommended for supplies (pencils, protractor, ruler, compass, etc)
- 6 inch ruler\* (inches and centimeters) – available in class (\$0.50)
- protractor\* (small clear) – available in class (\$0.50)
- 2 working/sharpened pencils at every class period
  - (even if you have mechanical pencils, you need two, in case one breaks – ONLY USE PENCILS FOR MATH WORK, no pens)
- 2 red pens (for checking)
- \$1 – for “keeper book”

## Geometry Supply List

- 3 ring binder (no spirals)
  - homework section
  - notes section
  - graph paper section
- section dividers for binder (at least 3 sections)
- notebook paper (college-ruled)
- graph paper (about ¼" spaces)
- binder pouch recommended for supplies (pencils, protractor, ruler, compass, etc)
- 6 inch ruler\* (inches and centimeters) – available in class (\$0.50)
- protractor\* (small clear) – available in class (\$0.50)
- compass\* with a wheel adjuster –available in classroom (\$3)
  - These are at times hard to find. They retail for \$5, I found them online for \$3.
- 2 working/sharpened pencils at every class period
  - (even if you have mechanical pencils, you need two, in case one breaks – ONLY USE PENCILS FOR MATH WORK, no pens)
- 2 red pens (for checking)
- calculator – TI-36X or TI-30X (the X is important), about \$15 at Wal-Mart, (a graphing calculator\*\* is NOT necessary, but okay)
- \$1 – for “keeper book”

\*I order these in bulk online to save money and to get the size/type that is easier to use in class.

\*\*We will use a graphing calculator (TI-84Plus, TI-84, or TI-83) for Algebra 2 and PreCalculus, but it is not necessary for Geometry.

## Pre-Calculus Supply List

- 3 ring binder (no spirals)
  - homework section
  - notes section
  - graph paper section
- section dividers for binder (at least 3 sections)
- notebook paper (college-ruled)
- graph paper (about ¼" spaces)
- binder pouch recommended for supplies (pencils, protractor, ruler, compass, etc)
- 6 inch ruler\* (inches and centimeters) – available in class (\$0.50)
- protractor\* (small clear) – available in class (\$0.50)
- compass – for drawing circles
- 2 working/sharpened pencils at every class period
  - (only use pencil for math work, no pens)
- 2 red pens (for checking)
- graphing calculator (TI-84 Plus, TI-84, or TI-83)
  - (the TI-83 is acceptable, but if you are buying new, I recommend TI-84 Plus, these are over \$100 – so try to plan ahead)
- \$1 – for “keeper book”

\*I order these in bulk online to save money and to get the size/type that is easier to use in class.
